Cadets “Saddle” Mustangs

Defeated! How would your St. Joseph's Cadets rebound after last week's loss? By getting back to what they do best, winning and beating their Week 7 opponent the Fairfield Warde Mustangs handily. Let's call it a wake up call. Watch out FCIAC foes... We're back and on a mission!

Behind the leadership of SJ quarterback Joseph Della Vecchia and running back / linebacker Tyler Matakevich, the Cadets made sure tonight's victory would be convincing and convincing it was. The 2 combined for nearly 500 yards of total offense, while the Hogs defense shutdown the Mustangs.

The Cadets received the opening kick off with junior LJ Hunt returning the ball 19 yards to start the game. Della Vecchia completed his first pass to Matakevich for 10 yards in what would turn out to be one heck of a show. Joe would finish the evening with over 250 yards passing and tack on 60 plus yards rushing, not to mention 4 total touchdowns (2 Pass * 2 Rush). While his counter part, the relentless Tyler would rush for 100 yards, receive nearly 80 yards and add 9 tackles to his performance. St. Joseph's scored first when Della Vecchia completed a 44 yard touchdown to wide receiver Patrick Mulligan. Kicker Casey Olayos kicked the extra point. Cadets 7 * Mustangs 0

The Hogs defense had one heck of a night. The defensive line made up of seniors, team captain Nick "the **Polar Bear**" Pulaski, Tim "the **Hitman**" Izzo, Tom "the **Warrior**" Walczyk and Shane "**O.B.**" O'Brien was a force to be reckoned with. Throw in the linebacking crew of Russ "**Dozer**" Renfer, Tony "**Civi**" Civitella, Sean "**Havoc**" Chinova and the "**Phenom**" himself... Matakevich, Fairfield's run game was obsolete.

On the Mustangs second possession Renfer tipped a pass which wound up in the hands of Mulligan for an interception, the first of 3 during the game. As the 1st quarter was winding down, Matakevich rumbled his way down the field on a 29 yard run making it first and goal inside the Fairfield 10 yard line. Della Vecchia completed a quick 4 yard pass to wide receiver Jerry Kramer. Matakevich was stopped short 1 yard of the goal as time expired.

The 2nd quarter began, with a second try being a charm as Tyler scored on a 1 yard up-n-over the top, crashing down in the end zone. Olayos kicked the extra point. You had this feeling that St Joes was going to score at will, but would Fairfield be able to counter? Indeed they did. The Mustangs sustained a long drive of their own taking the ball over 60 yards to score, but were unable to convert the extra point. Cadets 14 * Mustangs 6

The Cadets O took the field and as expected drove their way with Matakevich carrying the ball 2 times for 27 yards with Della Vecchia completing 2 more passes. Joe hit Tyler for 14 yards before connecting with sophomore Joe Burns for another SJ score with Olayos kicking the extra point. The Hogs D took the field again with O'Brien adding 2 more tackles, while Civitella, Walczyk and Chinova contributed forcing the Mustangs to punt. Della Vecchia "**Merlin**" worked his magic once again, completing passes to Matakevich for 37 yards and senior tight end, George "**Gates**" Nation for 14 more. Burns added a 5 yard rush before Della Vecchia saw an opening and scampered in for an 8 yard touchdown. Olayos kicked the extra point. Cadets 28 * Mustangs 6

On the ensuing kick off senior Justin Brantley and junior Trevor Dalling combined for a crushing tackle. The Hogs defense took control again when Chinova picked off the Mustangs quarterback on the very first play. Della Vecchia then completed a 44 yard pass to Nation which helped set a 2 yard score by Matakovich. Olayos kicked the extra point. The SJ special teams kicked off again, but Warde mishandles the ball and Renfer recovered it. These Mustangs just couldn't catch a break. Joe passed the ball to Tyler for an 11 yard game. Casey set up in an attempt to kick a 37 yard field goal, but the ball pushed left.

Half Time: Cadets 35 * Mustangs 6

The 3rd quarter opened with the Hogs on D and on the very first play Renfer sacked the quarterback. “**Dozer**” was doing it all by tackling, sacking, tipping and recovering! The Cadets weren't able to capitalize and turned the ball back over giving the Mustangs decent field position. Four plays later, Warde found the end zone for their second score. On SJ's next series of down the Mustangs forced the Cadets to punt. The Hogs weren't about to let Fairfield back in the game, so they returned the favor forcing them to punt. Della Vecchia connected with Nation once again for 16 more yards. Matakovich carried the ball 2 more times for 10 yards before Joe scrambled for 4 yards finding the end zone, his second rushing TD on the evening. Olayos kicked the extra point. Cadets 42 * Mustangs 12

Now here we are in the 4th quarter and this Hog defense stayed relentless. Defensive back Nick “the **Predator**” Prutting made 2 quick tackles, while Izzo and Renfer shared a sack. On the very next play Civitella intercepted a Mustang pass. The Cadets trotted back out on the field. Della Vecchia completed a 26 yard pass to Tony and on the very next play handed the ball off to him. “**Civi**” rumbled his way in for a 16 yard touchdown all but sealing Fairfield's fate.

St. Joseph's defense took the field one last time led by senior middle linebacker Pat “the **Punisher**” Magee who had 5 tackles inside of 5 minutes. The Hogs battled with tackles being made by seniors Erik Cranston and Jon Stine, along with juniors Will Dwinells, Ryan Finch, Ryan Mrozek and Dalling. Sophomore Mike Grasso added 2 tackles as well. However, the Fairfield Warde Mustangs were able to score one last time in the final seconds of the game.

St. Joseph pummels Fairfield Warde

FAIRFIELD -- Following his team's first loss of the season at No. 1 ranked New Canaan last week, St. Joseph coach Joe Della Vecchia was hoping that his team wouldn't suffer a lingering aftereffect in the Cadets' game with Fairfield Warde.

Fortunately for St. Joseph, Della Vecchia's son, Joe, was on the field. The junior quarterback threw for 259 yards and two touchdowns and ran for two more as the Cadets rolled 49-18 on Friday night at Tetreau / Davis Field.

"He made a ton of plays tonight and did a great job," Joe Della Vecchia said of his son.

Junior running back Tyler Matakevich rushed for 74 yards and a pair of touchdowns as well, as the Cadets improved to 6-1 on the season.

"I was worried all week that we'd be still stinging from last week," the elder Della Vecchia said. "We came out to play, and we took it to them early."

St. Joseph took control of the game in the second quarter as the Cadets turned a 7-0 advantage at the end of one quarter into a 35-6 shellacking at halftime.

Matakevich tallied his first rushing score of the game on fourth-and-goal at the Warde 1-yard line to put the Cadets up 14-0.

St. Joseph was also able to silence Warde's impressive running game as the Cadets held all-FCIAC fullback Tommy McNamara to just 18 yards rushing.

"They stopped our run," Warde head coach Duncan DellaVolpe said. "I give them credit for that."

Warde cut the St. Joseph advantage to 14-6 on a seven-play drive in which Mustangs' receiver Terrell Walden caught three passes for 57 yards, including a 12-yard touchdown.

Walden caught a second touchdown later in the night on a six-yard reception from Burns as well.

"We've been waiting for Terrell to come," DellaVolpe said. "He stepped up big for us."

The Cadets responded with three straight scores to close the half, including a touchdown on their next possession when Della Vecchia hit Joe Burns with a 17-yard touchdown.

After the Cadets received a punt, Della Vecchia took the squad down the field 64 yards capped by his own 7-yard run.

Freshman Cadets Trounce Fairfield Warde 26-7

Week 7 action saw the Freshman Cadets firing on all cylinders in a 26-7 home victory at Dalling Sports Complex against the Fairfield Warde Mustangs. After a tough start to the season, Coach Luchansky and Coach Buygi have turned the season around with Cadet victories in two of the last three contests.

Harry Leroux (85), Conor Gebo (41) and Matt Batten (4) were selected as game captains. St. Joes won the toss and elected to receive. It was the start of a great afternoon for the Cadets. **Pat Boyle (10)** took the helm at QB. The solid Cadet offensive line anchored by **Right Tackle Andrew Zaprazalka (78) Right Guard Mike Raucci (72), Center Kevin Haynes (74), Left Tackle Rob Roehrich (66), and Left Guard Brian Gavin (65)** protected **Boyle** all day. The Hogs opening drive was indicative of how the day would go focusing on the outstanding running of **Kyron Crawford (23)**. On the third play from scrimmage, **Crawford** found daylight and the end zone putting the Cadets up 6-0. It was the start of a 4-touchdown day for **Crawford**.

The Mustangs took the ensuing kickoff and had a long sustained drive ending with a short TD run. The extra point was good and the Mustangs were up 7-6 at the end of the first quarter. As it turned out, that was the only Mustang score of the day.

The Cadets got the ball back with **Brett Olayos (8)** at QB. Olayos immediately hooked up with speedster **Jake Pellitier (2)** on a flash and go. The Cadet drive stalled and a **Mike Pulaski (45)** punt gave the Mustangs the ball. The outstanding Cadets defense smothered Fairfield Warde dashing all hopes of moving the ball.

The defensive line was lead by **Haynes (74)**, **Donnelly (56)**, **Roehrich (66)** and **Raucci (72)**. **Connor Gebo (41)** , **Mike Pulaski (45)** **Leroux (84)**, continue to make standout plays at linebacker. **Matt Batten (4)**, **Jake Pelletier (2)**, **Ryan Mulligan (35)**, and **Bobby Brennan (83)** locked down the defense. After a Mustang punt, Boyle went back to work with a terrific pass to **Pulaski (45)** setting up another 60 yard **Crawford** TD run. A 2-point conversion pass to **Pulaski** was good and the Cadets went into halftime up 14-7.

The third quarter saw Fairfield desperately trying to move the ball. The defense smothered them at every turn. When Fairfield went to the air, **Mike Pulaski** was there to intercept an errant pass. **Boyle** wasted no time by going long to **Jake Pelletier** with a long reception. Once again, the Cadets went to **Kyron Crawford** on the ground for his third touchdown of the day.

The Cadets special teams played well. On the ensuing kickoff, **Kevin Fitzgerald (30)** made a great open field tackle. The Mustangs just could not move the ball. **Alex Hardy (88)**, **Bobby Brennan (83)**, **Dillon O' Meara (81)**, and **Justin Zimnoch (89)** shut them down. The Mustangs tried to go to the air and found Cadets DB **Dillon O' Meara (81)** there for the interception.

On the final scoring drive, Olayos looked great with a 35-yard pass completion to sure handed **Jake Pelletier**. **Crawford** put the finishing touches on the drive with a 36 TD pass reception to put the Cadets up 26-7.
