Tuition Payment Options

The following totals are calculated based on 2020-2021 tuition costs *without* financial aid or scholarship.

1-Time Payment	Due: June Amount: \$17,100
Payment by Semester	Due: June & December Amount: \$8,550
Monthly Payments (through a Union Savings Bank Loan, 4.25% interest)	Due: Monthly, June-April Amount: \$1,587.77

SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID

FINANCIAL AID (NEED-BASED)

The Financial Aid Committee reviews and distributes financial aid for new student applicants based on financial need. The Financial Aid process is optional. In order to be considered for financial aid, you must file and complete a FACTS application by the deadline (November 17, 2021). If completed after the deadline, financial aid is not guaranteed.

SCHOLARSHIP (MERIT-BASED)

St Joseph High School offers several academic scholarships to incoming students. To be eligible for these scholarships, prospective students must take either the first or second entrance exam (October 30 or November 13) and place in the 90th percentile and above. Scholarship recipients are notified via their acceptance letter and are invited to a scholarship reception in January. These awards are renewed each year, provided the student maintains a cumulative academic average of 90% or better, and maintains a positive and responsible presence within the St Joseph community.

There are three categories of merit-based awards:

THE PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A four-year, half-tuition scholarship offered to entering eighth grade students who score 98% or above on the entrance exam, and have the academic record and teacher recommendations reflective of their high scholastic ability.

THE PRINCIPAL'S SCHOLARSHIP

A \$16,000 award over four years (\$4,000 per year) and is awarded to those students who score between 94-97% on the entrance exam, and have the academic record and teacher recommendations reflective of their high scholastic ability.

THE CADET SCHOLARSHIP

A \$12,000 award over four years (\$3,000 per year) and is awarded to those students who score between 90-93% on the entrance exam, and have the academic record and teacher recommendations reflective of their high scholastic ability.
