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	Complete your tuition agreement and select your tuition payment option.
	Sign the record release form and send it to your child's current school. This form indicates that final transcripts and medical forms should be sent to St. Joseph High School.
	Connect with your child's physician to have a copy of your child's physical and immunization record sent to our School Nurse, Mrs. Miller.
	Log into your Blackbaud account and update your child's emergency contacts (find video instructions on the New Student Webpage).
