This World Language Placement Exam serves as a baseline assessment for students who wish to be considered for a World Language placement higher than level 1. The exam will take students about 1 hour to complete, and is comprised of 100 questions. Most of the questions will be in a multiple choice, or matching format. All students will be notified of their placement by the first week of July.
