Admission Application and Financial Aid Application Deadline: November 17, 2020



Step 1.) Apply Online

- Our online application can be found at (<u>www.sjcadets.org</u>)
- Your online application requires an essay (**Tip:** Write your essay in a word document and copy and paste it into your application to catch any errors! See the Admission Team's essay outline and best practices at sicadets.org/apply)



Step 2.) Submit Math and English Teacher Recommendation Forms

- Math and English teacher recommendation forms can be sent electronically by entering your teacher's email address in your online application.
- A PDF recommendation form may also be found on our website. (**Tip:** 8th grade teacher recommendations are preferred, use your first few weeks at school to make a positive impression!)



Step 3.) Send your 7th and 8th grade report cards to St Joes

• Submit a records release form to your middle school records office to release 7th and 8th grade report cards and standardized test scores to SJ (form within online application or located at www.sicadets.org/applynow).

Step 4.) Take an Entrance Exam

- Sign up to take your Entrance Exam (High School Placement Test) at St Joseph High School on October 31 and November 14.
- The Exam is a one-time test that measures reading, writing and math skills.
- SJHS offers a 2-day prep course October 16-17 that concludes with lunch tickets to the homecoming game! Learn more at sjcadets.org/admissions
- *If students are interested in receiving extra time (time and a half) accommodations on the entrance exam, an up to date IEP or 504 must be submitted to the Director of Enrollment one week before the exam.
